This is the second year in a row we have won this grant for \$10,000. With these two grants and the recent \$15,000 grant from the Community Foundation of North Central Massachusetts, Squannacook Greenways' capital campaign is now above \$117,000, almost 4/5th of the way to our goal of \$150,000.

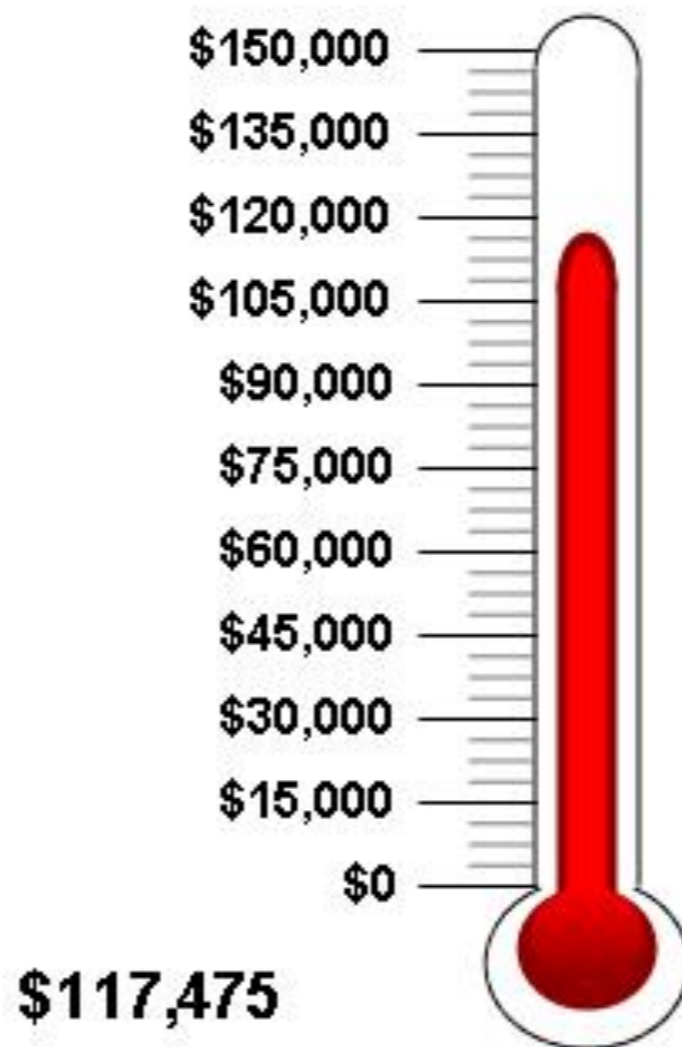
